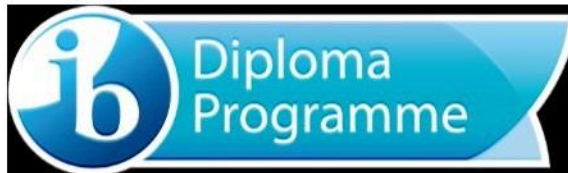

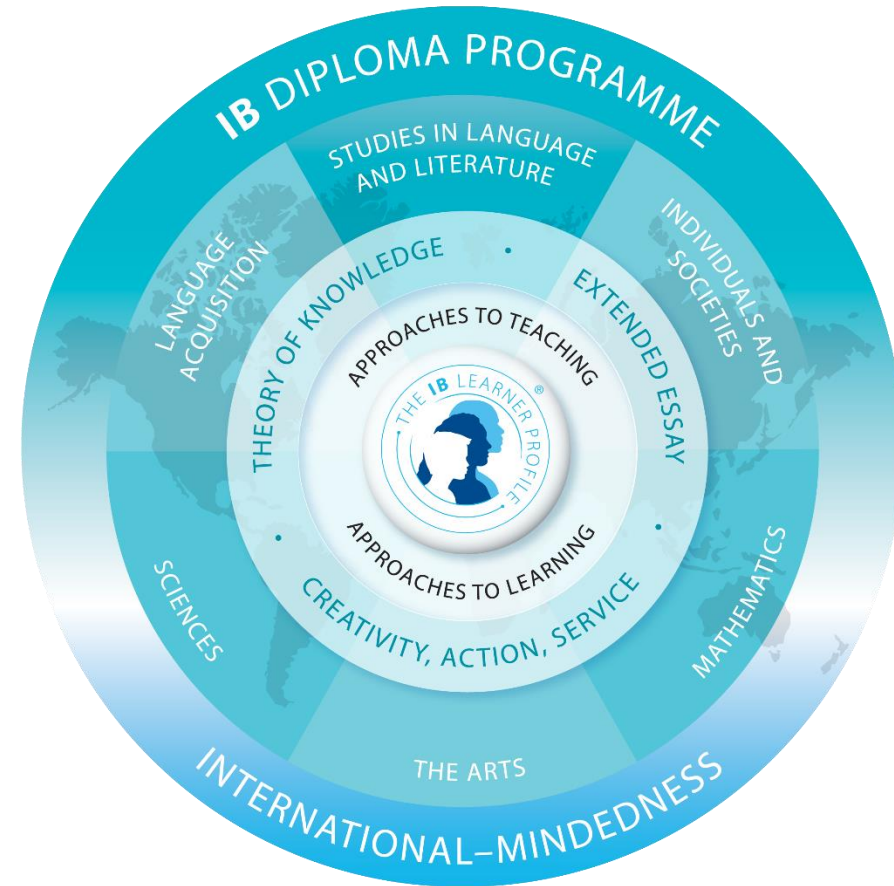

Diploma Requirements

Reminder of IB Diploma Requirements

- When considering classes for 10th grade, you need to start thinking about what IB courses you are thinking of taking in 11th and 12th grade.
- In 11th and 12th grade All IB DP students take 1 course in each of the 6 IB subject groups
- The Groups are:
 - Group 01: Language A: English Literature
 - Group 02: Language B: Language Acquisition
 - Group 03: Individual and Societies
 - Group 04: The Sciences
 - Group 05: Mathematics
 - Group 06: The Arts or Elective



Diploma Requirements

Of those 6 classes

Students must take

- 3 Higher Level Courses
- 3 Standard Level Courses

OR....students can take

- 4 Higher Level Courses
- 2 Standard Level Courses

Diploma Requirements

- All IB Diploma students are required to take IB English Literature Higher Level
- All IB Diploma students are required to take IB History of the Americas Higher level
- All IB Diploma students will continue their Language Acquisition (French or Spanish) sequence.
- During their senior year, all IB Diploma students are required to take TOK



Diploma Requirements

- You can only take 2 IB exams junior year that will count towards your IB Diploma.
- IB Diploma students must complete the following Core Components over Junior and Senior years:
 - Extended Essay
 - CAS – Creativity, Activity, and Service
 - Theory of Knowledge (*Senior required Class*)



Diploma Requirements

Any additional IB courses you take over these six IB courses will not count towards the IB diploma, and they are considered a general elective class like when taking AP courses or other non-IB courses.

Career-related Requirements

Reminder of IB Career Requirements

- Complete 2 years of career pathway and sit for the industry certification
- Pass minimum 2 IB courses, 3 to 4 are recommended
- Complete the Reflective Project Essay, Service Learning, Language Development and the PPS course.
- Meet state of Florida Graduation requirements



Career-related Requirements

- Students should choose IB Courses related to their career pathway
- One of the 2 courses must extended over two year
- *CP Students should plan on taking one IB exam junior year*

IB Registration

- It will be extremely hard to meet with parents during this time.

IB Registration

- Students in 10th and 11th will receive access to their “IB” registration forms on Friday , Jan-20. They can be found on the website. Freshmen in the next few weeks.
- They will fill out their registration form at home using the documents and resources.
- They will submit their requests on a google form
- Students will meet with Mr. Blackmon/Ms. Cechman 1-on-1 to finalize their registration.
- Meetings start next week. Rising seniors 1st, then rising juniors, then rising sophomores.

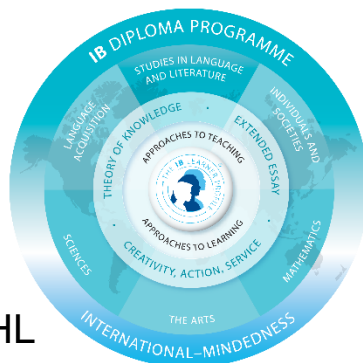

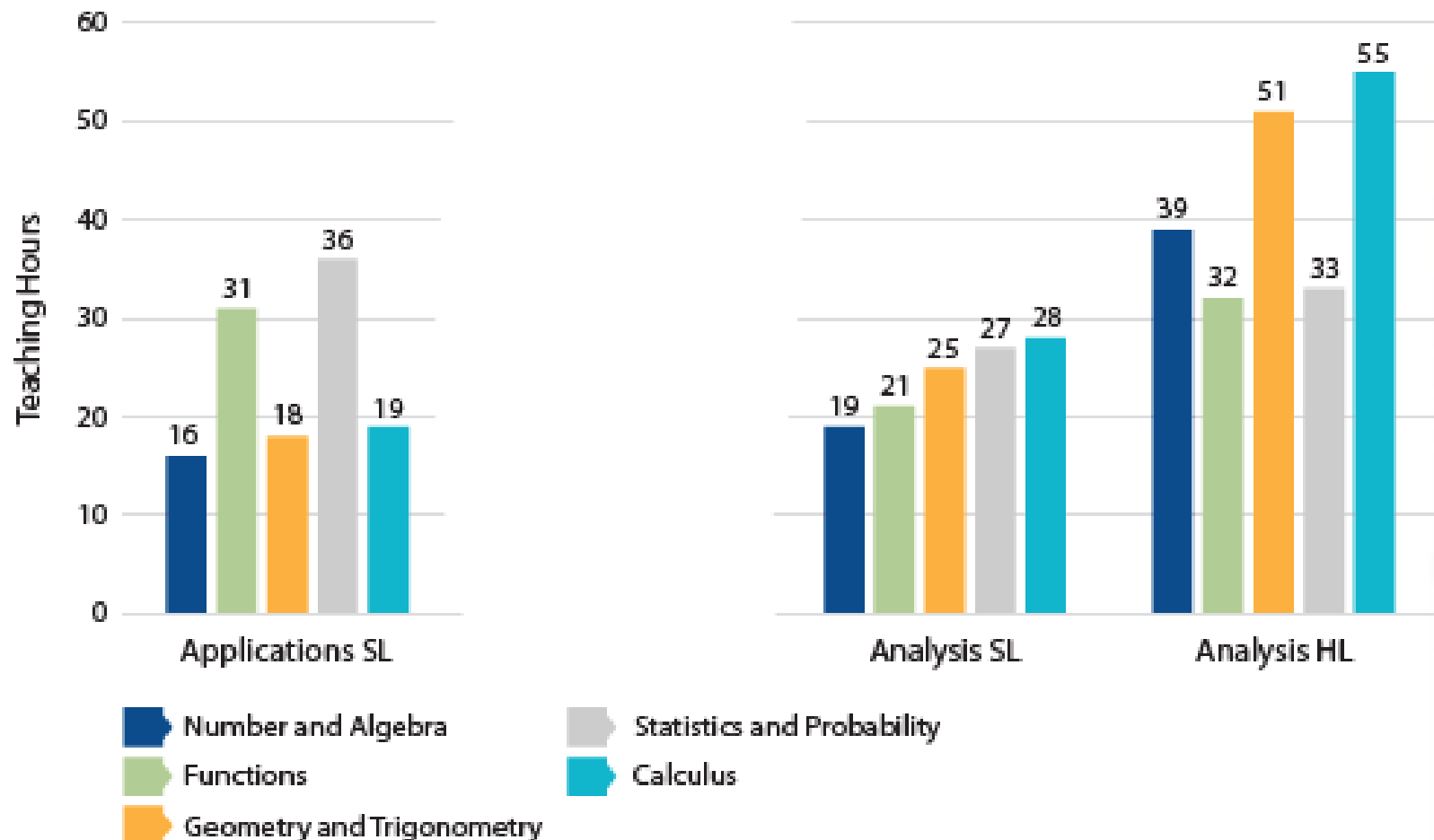
