

## Free SAT Prep

Orange County Public Schools has been invited to participate in the alpha testing of the Khan Academy-College Board SAT prep pilot. Khan Academy and College Board are teaming up to create **free SAT prep**, and we're one of a few districts invited to help them create these new tools, which will officially launch to the public in May 2015. This is an exciting opportunity for students in our district to prepare for spring 2015 SATs while helping Khan Academy develop SAT prep tools that will benefit millions of students over time.

The timeline is tight, but an incredible no cost opportunity for OCPS students! All students must register through Khan Academy by **NOVEMBER 15th**.

During the alpha test, our students will be able to take timed practice SATs (Math & Reading sections) on Khan Academy between December 1st and January 31st. Participants will be expected to complete at least one practice SAT on Khan Academy during this time, and complete a brief feedback survey at the end.

To participate, **individual students will need to do the following:**

1. Register by **November 15th using** this link [[this survey](#)] to the student registration survey Google form. To participate in the alpha pilot students will need to have Khan Academy **account using school email addresses**, (User: [StudentID@students.ocps.net](mailto:StudentID@students.ocps.net) Password: 8-digit birthday in **YYYYMMDD** format) as they are only enabling emails originating from the OCPS domain to access the alpha test. 2. **Take at least one full practice test (at once or one section at a time) between December 1st and January 31st.** Students will receive an email from Khan Academy with a link to the "alpha" in early December.
3. **Complete a brief feedback survey after the alpha.** Khan Academy send the link via email in late January or early February.
4.
